General Safety Precautions:

- Dispose of Packaging thoughtfully.
- Do not exceed the maximum weight rating of 150kg.
- Load the trolley evenly for safe operation.
- Place heavy items at the bottom to keep the centre of gravity as low as possible.
- Secure your load with straps before transporting to ensure that the load doesn't slip or fall.
- Take care when negotiating steps or declines.
- Do not transport people on the trolley.
- Do not use the trolley if it is damaged.

1. Installing the wheels



Using a spanner and socket, fix the four wheels onto the frame using the provided fixings. Locknuts are used to help prevent loosening during 'bumpy' transportation, be sure to check these from time to time and make adjustments if necessary.

2. Unfolding the frame handle



Holding the lower part of the frame down, pull back on the handle until it clicks into position.

3. Raising or lowering the frame handle



The handle can be raised and lowered easily by using your foot to push down on the lower section of the handle frame as shown. With your foot held down firmly, you will be able to raise and lower the handle with ease.

4. Extending the loading platform



The loading platform is telescopic which allows for two platform sizes. To extend the platform, pull up on the black clip as shown and rotate the clip 180 degrees. You can now pull out the frame to extend the platform size. Be sure to lock the frame in place with the clip.
