with Crawl Tunnel

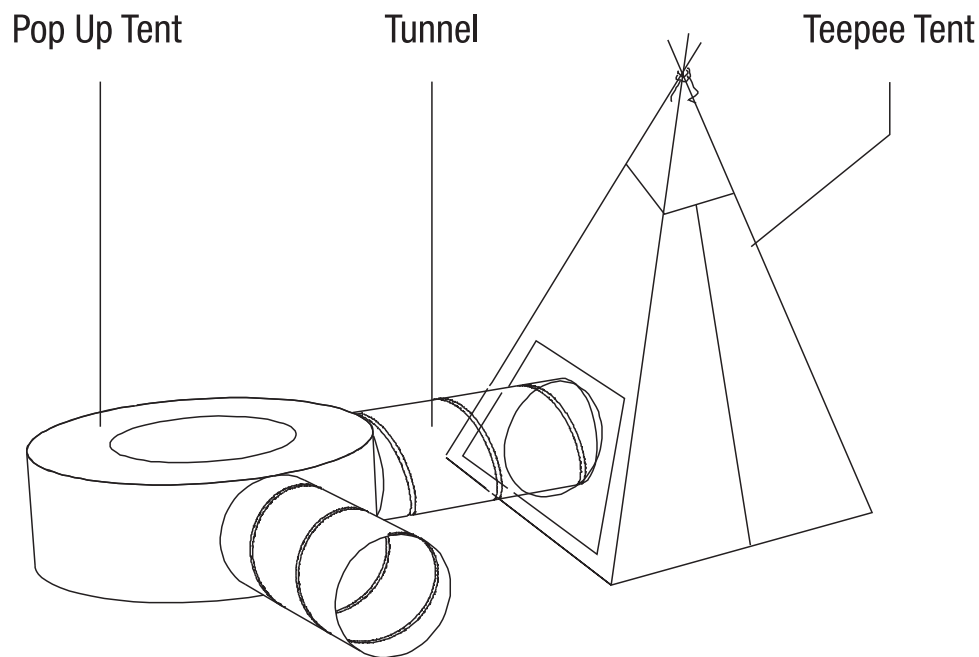

### 3.Crawl Tunnel Assembly

Join the Pop-up tents and Teepee tents together by inserting the crawl tunnel ends through the holes in both tents. Fix the tents and crawl tunnels by using a fabric loop and tab to tie to each other.

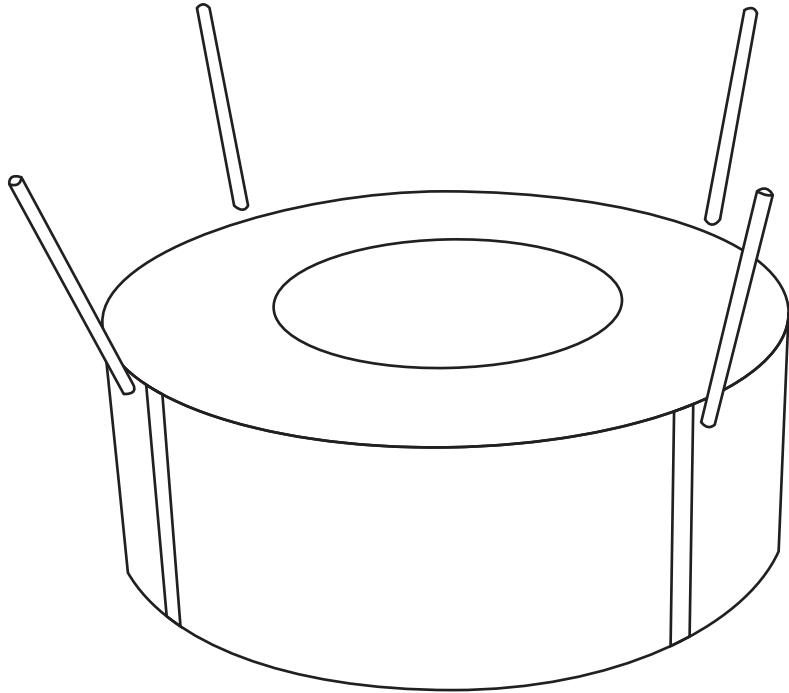
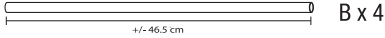

1.Pop Up Tent Assembly

To erect the tent, feed the rods into the four sheaths on the tent fabric.

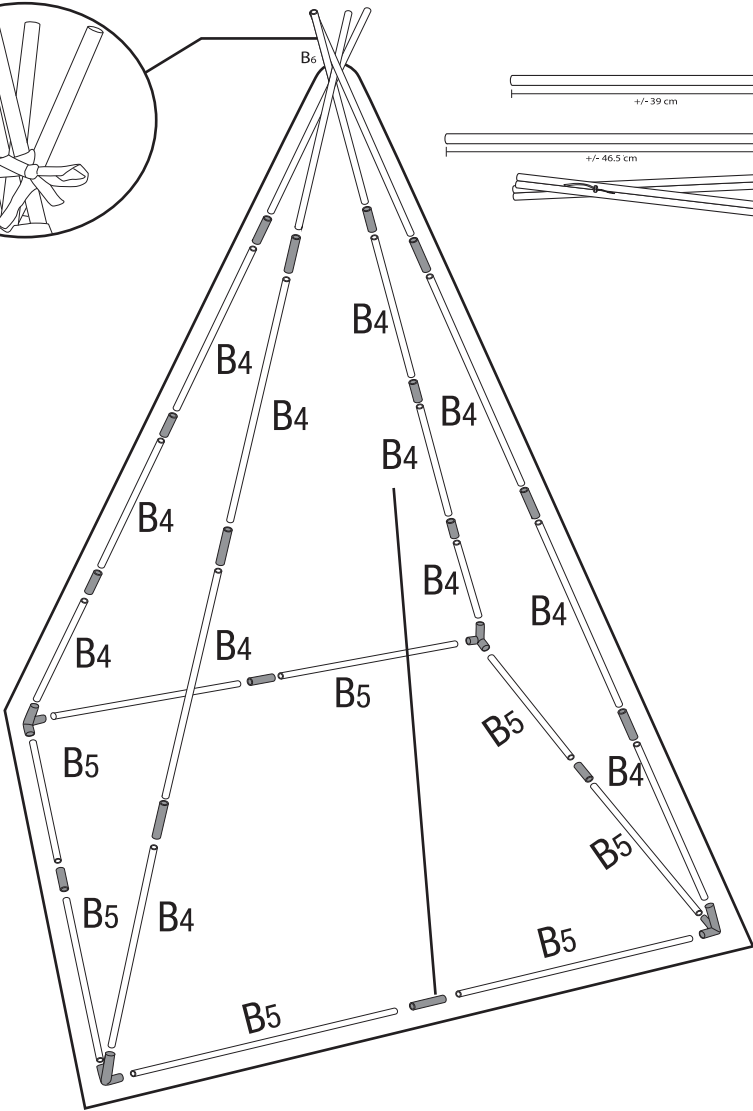
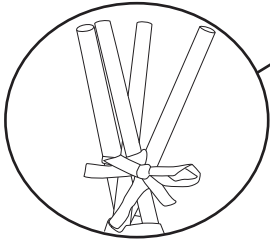

2.Teepee Tent Assembly

Make the square base first using the rods and connectors shown in diagram.

Next, assemble the 4 corner tent poles with the connectors and attach to the base frame.

Cover the frame with the tent fabric, and tie the lace to secure the tent poles together at the top.
